## MTA METRO-NORTH RAILROAD'S GUARANTEED RIDE HOME PROGRAM

MTA Metro-North monthly **UniTicket** customers who ride the Ulster-Poughkeepsie LINK to Poughkeepsie Station and commute to Grand Central Terminal or Harlem-125th Street can get up to two free taxi rides per month to their car or home from Poughkeepsie Station during the few select times when the Ulster-Poughkeepsie LINK is not scheduled to ride a train.

### HERE'S HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS

Your guaranteed ride will be provided by **Delroy Taxi (845-452-1222)** at Poughkeepsie Station. Just follow these simple steps:

1. Present your valid UniTicket at any ticket window in Grand Central Terminal or, between 6:40 AM and 7:51 PM, at Harlem-125th Street Station.
2. The ticket agent will stamp the UniTicket and give you a validated voucher. (Laminated UniTickets will not be accepted.)
3. Take a train listed on the Guaranteed Ride Home Program Schedule (available at [www.mta.info](http://www.mta.info)) to Poughkeepsie Station, and go to the **Delroy Taxi** stand. (If you like, call the number above so the driver is expecting you.)
4. Present your voucher to the driver when you enter the taxi. (The voucher is good only for the day of the requested ride.)

It's that simple! You'll be taken to your car, home, or to any location in Ulster or Orange counties within 20 miles of Poughkeepsie Station.

**Guaranteed Ride Home Program Hours**  
Monday through Friday (excluding holidays) during off-peak<sup>‡</sup> times for all trains leaving Grand Central Terminal not met by an Ulster-Poughkeepsie LINK bus.

#### PLEASE NOTE:

The program cannot be used when there is a delay in bus or train service due to breakdown or other problems.

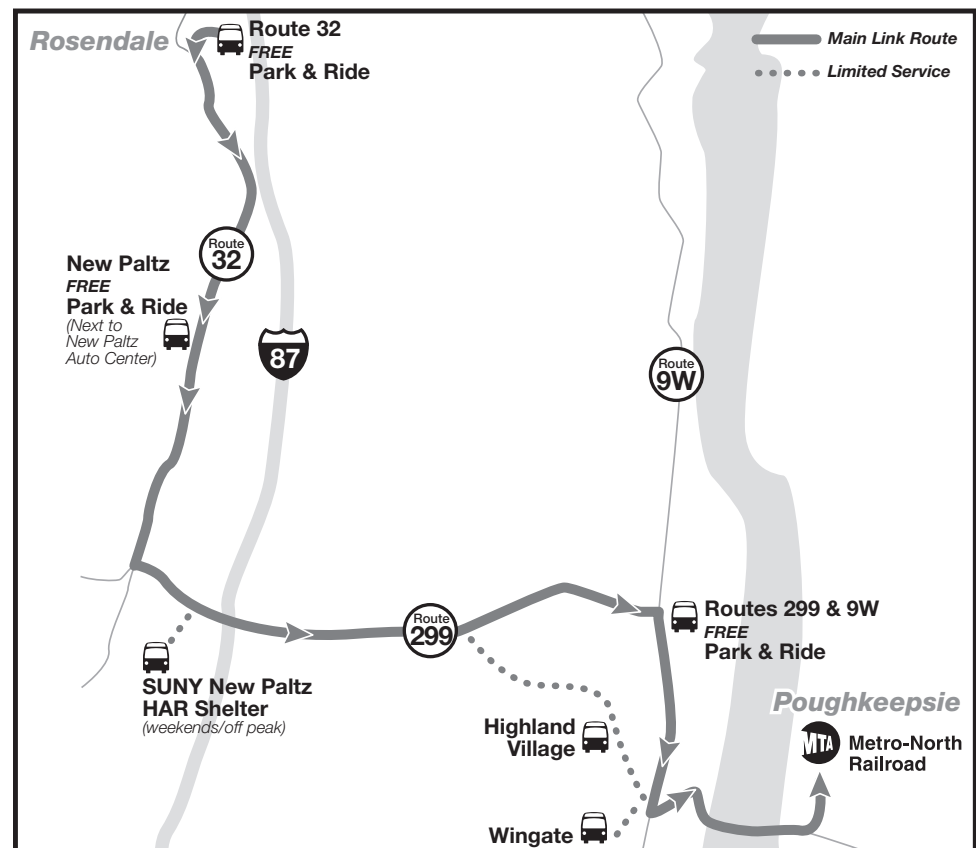
